Did You Know...

At age 13, encouraged by the local pastor, her family allowed her to go to a boarding school run by nuns. She returned home at age 18 with her teacher's certificate and state license. She believed that she was called to live in the convent as a nun. This calling was to take some time, during which her love for Jesus and her ability as a teacher continued to grow.

Francesca took her religious vows in 1877 and added Xavier to her name to honor the Jesuit priest Francis Xavier. She became the Superior of the House of Providence where she taught and gathered a small community of women to the religious life. She founded the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (M.S.C.). In its first 5 years they established 7 homes and a free school. She came to the attention of Pope Leo XIII. Cuando Francesca tenía 13 años el pastor de la comunidad la ánimo y su familia le permitió que estudiara en un internado dirigido por monjas. Ella regreso a casa a los 18 años de edad con un certificado de maestra y una licencia del estado. Ella creía que era llamada a vivir en el convento como monja. Este llamado tomo tiempo, mientras su amor por Jesús y su habilidad de ser maestra seguía creciendo.

Francesca tomó los votos religiosos en 1877 y le añadió Xavier a su nombre en honor al sacerdote Jesuita Francisco Javier. Ella se convirtió en la Superior de la Casa de la Providencia donde enseñó y reunió una pequeña comunidad de mujeres a la vida religiosa. Fundó las Hermanas Misioneras del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús. En sus primeros 5 años se establecieron 7 viviendas y una escuela gratuita. Ella llamo la atención del Papa León XIII. ¡Busque más información sobre la Madre Cabrini la próxima semana!

Malachi 3:19-20
2 Thessalonians 3:7-12

"It will lead to your giving testimony." —Luke 21:13, RNAB

"Persecutions are great opportunities for giving testimony to Jesus. A testimony is our personal witness to what the Lord Jesus has done in our life. Did you know that Satan is defeated by our testimony to Jesus? "They defeated [Satan] by the blood of the Lamb and the word of their testimony" (see Rv 12:11). Jesus uses our testimony to soften the hearts of those who listen. People can disagree with our theological positions, but no one can deny what happened to us and our personal experience of and relationship with Jesus.

Do not be terrified or perturbed (see Lk 21:9). Jesus promises you this: "I will give you words and a wisdom which none of your adversaries can take exception to or contradict" (Lk 21:15).

Your testimony to what Jesus has done in your life is a valuable witness in favor of the Lord in the court of each human heart and mind who will hear you. God is constantly planting seeds in each heart. Who knows when that heart will open to Jesus? Perhaps your testimony will cause that person to give their life to Jesus or bring them one step closer. Therefore, "never be ashamed of your testimony to our Lord" (2 Tm 1:8).

The court is in session, and Jesus is on trial. The Spirit is calling you to the witness stand. Will you pass the testimony test?" (PRESENTATION MINISTRIES)
