

Did You Know...

Mother Cabrini went to Rome and asked the Pope to allow her to go to China to establish missions. The Pope sent her to the United States to help Italian immigrants. On March 31, 1889 she and 6 sisters left for the United States. On this crossing they spent many days in a great storm. In spite of her great fear of water she encouraged her fellow sisters, who were very frightened, to minister to those on board who were ill. In spite of her lifelong fear of water, Mother Cabrini would cross the ocean 25 times during her 28 year missionary work.



While in Seattle, Washington in 1909, Mother Cabrini became a citizen of the United States of America. Her missionary travels took her to New York, Pennsylvania, Illinois, Louisiana, Colorado, California, Washington State, Central and South America and Europe.

Mother Cabrini died December 22, 1917 while preparing Christmas candy for the children. During her 28 year mission, she was responsible for establishing 67 missionary institutions ministering to the sick and poor. She is entombed at the Saint Frances Cabrini Shrine, part of the Mother Cabrini High School in Manhattan, New York. Mother Frances Xavier Cabrini was canonized in Rome in 1946, the first American citizen Saint.

Sabías Que...

Madre Cabrini fue a Roma y le pidió al Papa que le permitiera ir a China para establecer misiones. El Papa la envió a los Estados Unidos para ayudar a los inmigrantes italianos. El 31 de marzo 1889 ella y 6 hermanas se fueron a los Estados Unidos. Durante este viaje pasaron muchos días en una gran tormenta. A pesar de su gran miedo al agua, ella animó a sus hermanas, que estaban muy asustadas, para ayudar a las personas a bordo que estaban enfermas. A pesar de su gran miedo al agua, Madre Cabrini cruzaría el mar 25 veces durante sus 28 años de trabajo misionero.

Mientras estaba en Seattle, Washington, en 1909, la Madre Cabrini se hizo ciudadana de los Estados Unidos de América. Sus viajes misioneros la llevaron a Nueva York, Pennsylvania, Illinois, Luisiana, Colorado, California, Estado de Washington, Centro y Sur América y Europa. Madre Cabrini falleció el 22 de diciembre del 1917, mientras que preparaba dulces de Navidad para los niños. Durante sus 28 de misionera, fue responsable de establecer 67 instituciones misioneras ministrando a los enfermos y los pobres. Está sepultada en el santuario Saint Frances Cabrini, que es parte de la Escuela Madre Cabrini en Manhattan, Nueva York. Madre Francisca Javier Cabrini fue canonizada en Roma en 1946, la primera Santa ciudadana Americana.
